Oak Marsh

18 HOLES | PAR 72 | 6,471 YARDS

Designed by Pete Dye | Renovated in 2025

The Pete Dye-designed Oak Marsh course provides the ultimate group golf experience at Omni Amelia Island Resort & Spa. Built in 1972, this 6,471-yard course is noted for its tight fairways and small greens, meandering along serpentine salt marsh creeks and through the moss-draped heritage oaks for which Amelia Island is famous. With five tee options, the modernized layout was designed by Beau Welling to meet the requirements of today's game brought on by technological advancements in equipment, providing a high-quality and consistent playing experience.

CHAMPIONSHIP GOLF

Long Point

18 HOLES | PAR 72 | 6,679 YARDS

Designed by Tom Fazio | Renovated in 2022

The Tom Fazio-designed Long Point course is an exclusive members-only course. The award-winning championship course completed in 1987 has plenty to challenge golfers with tight fairways, unexpected water hazards and undulating, elevated greens. The course winds its way past dense pine and oak forests, marshland and even sand dunes. Visiting golfers may find the ocean-facing par 3 holes a challenge, and five of the holes on the back nine are sure to enhance their focus. With exceptional gameplay and views to match, it's no surprise that this course has been named one of the "Top 50 Courses in Florida" by Golfweek.

Little Sandy

10 HOLES | 931 YARDS

Designed by Beau Welling

Little Sandy features 10 holes nestled around Red Maple Lake, ranging from 30 to 125 yards, and an 18-hole putting course. Playing through a picturesque lowland oak marsh habitat, this short course provides a traditional, yet fun-focused golf experience for all ages and abilities.

The course offers an idyllic setting as nearly all holes are played along Red Maple Lake's water that contrast sandy native grass areas, dunes, and diverse wildlife habitat.

Built in 2022, the Beau Welling design for Little Sandy was intentional to create an environment that promotes camaraderie and community. Playability and a fun atmosphere are emphasized to cater to families and those new to the game, but the course also offers strategic tests of golf and bold and contoured greens that will challenge more experienced golfers. One notable feature is the 10th hole that plays to an island green presenting a dramatic close to the round.

Little Sandy's covered deck features beautiful views and is the perfect spot to enjoy a snack or libation.

The oceanfront resort's golfing legacy began in 1972, with the Pete Dye designed Oak Marsh Course. The Long Point Course followed; a Tom Fazio masterpiece completed in 1987. Both courses offer their own challenges and an exhilarating group golf experience, from navigating bunkers and elevated greens to avoiding the many water hazards and magnificent scenic distractions along the way.

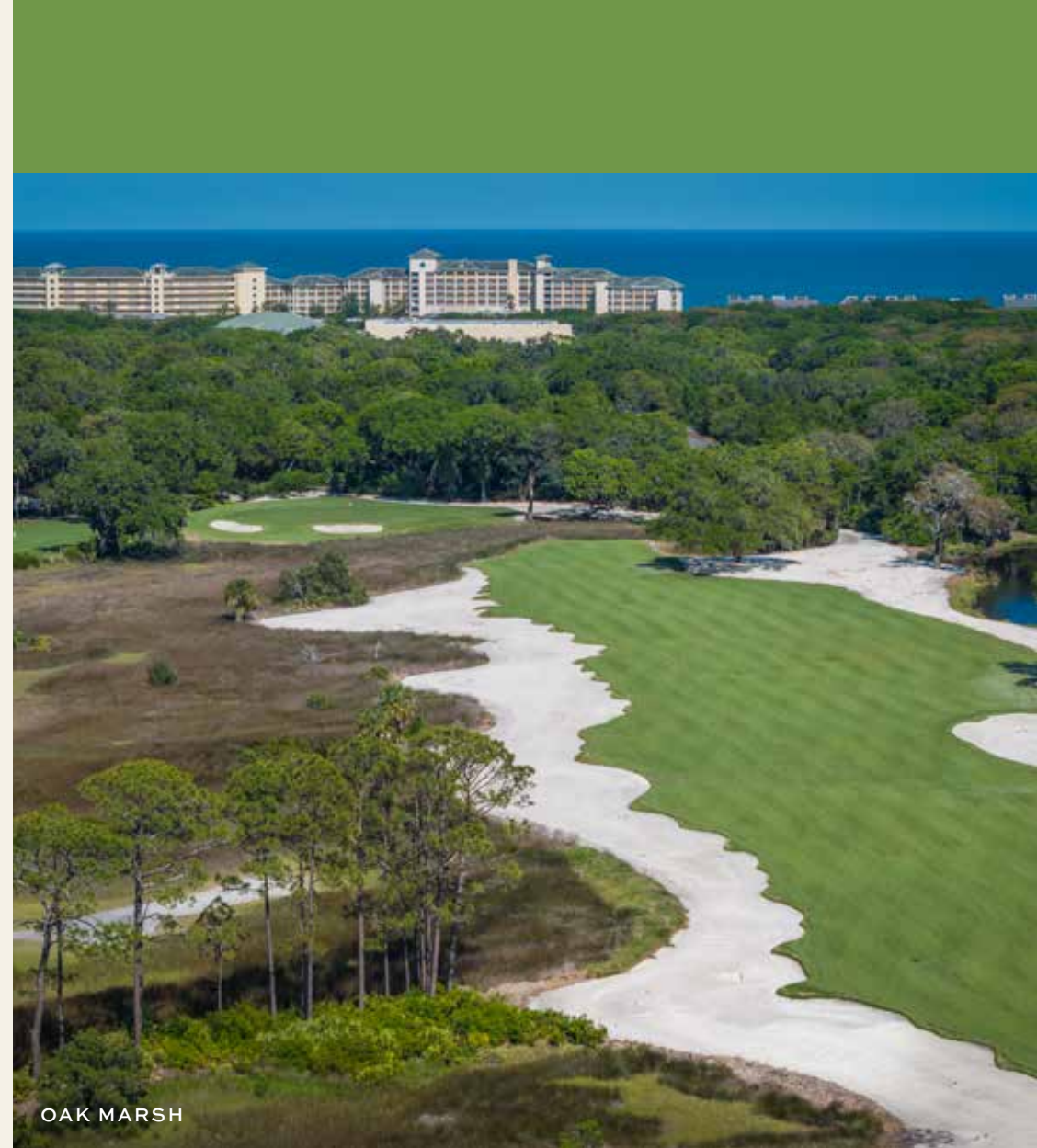

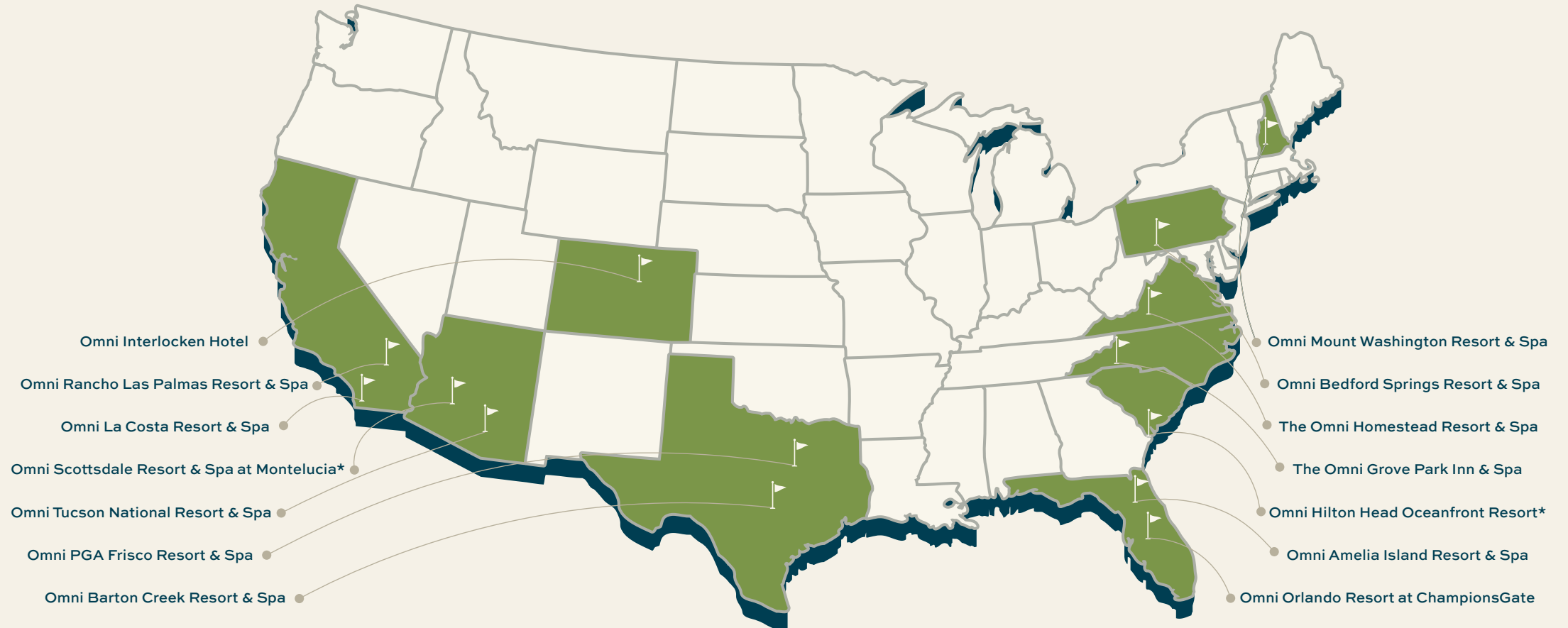
