The lobby will quickly become the perfect venue for guests to meet and mingle throughout their stay.

THE PEAK | Just off the lobby will be a dazzling new lounge inviting guests to come in and relax over cocktails. The racetrack-style bar is the centerpiece of the venue with a lacquered turquoise façade and evening-sky glass pendants scattered overhead like stars in the sky. With both indoor and outdoor seating overlooking the Sweetwater pool, The Peak will be an alluring spot to gather after a day of meetings, golf, sightseeing or relaxation.

TERRA COTTA CAFÉ | The new casual coffee market welcoming guests to start their day with a full range of coffee, tea and pastries for breakfast on the go or for a mid-afternoon pick-meup with both indoor and outdoor seating.
